



Aims of these six sessions on main 'six lessons' pag

Objectives for this session – the students recap what they have learned in the last 5 sessions, think what they can do to campaign for human rights and begin to prepare a campaign.

	Materials
<p>Recap with the whole group of the things they have learned in the past five weeks.</p> <p>What do they think about this? Which things do they most care about or is it the whole issue? They have spotted some things that are very wrong -is there anything they can do?</p>	<p>First slide</p>
<p>Pairs or small groups make a long list of things that can be done. Collect this on the board.</p> <p>Look at the slide of activities by young people that was made by another project – does this add anything they hadn't thought of?</p> <p>Which of these things do they think are most effective? What needs to be done for each of them?</p>	<p>Other project activities photo</p>
<p>Work in groups. Tell them that we are going to make a campaign together on one of the issues that they identified above as most important to them. If more than one subject, allocate a subject each to different groups. But it is OK if they all choose the same thing!</p>	

<p>Work in groups. Each group is going to discuss what they are going to do and prepare plans and materials for a campaign as far as they can. Teacher supports.</p>	<p>Planning an activity – lots of questions</p>
<p>Feedback to the whole group – Each group explains their plans. The main group decides if they want to pursue all or some of these activities and also when and how.</p>	
<p>This is the last session, and any follow-up depends on the group and the school. It would be good to make a space to follow some of these activities through.</p>
