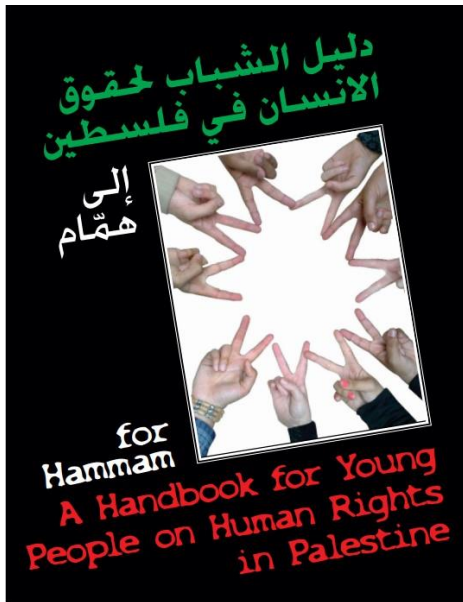


(1) Which of these are true, which are false?
